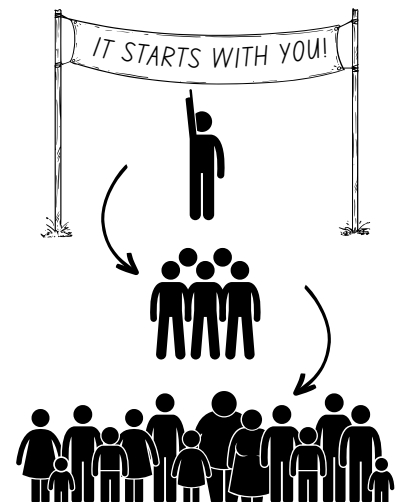

IMPORTANT Client Information - Please Read!

It's our mission to help our clients remain independent. We do that in a number of ways. Our staff coordinates rides, grocery deliveries, prescription pick-ups, & more! We work hard to make sure that clients receive the support they need and that both clients and volunteers have a rewarding experience!

In order to make that happen, **we need to reduce the number of last-minute requests.**

These last-minute changes result in our staff putting other requests on hold, require multiple calls and messages back and forth, and sometimes, even rearranging rides and volunteers that are already scheduled.

By calling ahead, **you allow us to make the best use of staff and volunteer time. You are also helping make sure that there are volunteers available for other clients who need help.** Our staff and volunteers are amazing and do their best to be flexible, but even they can't be everywhere and do everything at once 😊

So, to make scheduling easier, we are going back to enforcing our 2 business-day notice for clients who need to schedule a service.

Figuring out what 2 business days means can get confusing when you throw in what time of day you call and weekends. **But we've got you covered in the chart below!**

If your request is on an upcoming:	Then, call us on:
Monday	the Wednesday before
Tuesday	the Thursday before
Wednesday	the Friday before
Thursday	the Monday before
Friday	the Tuesday before
Saturday	the Wednesday before
Sunday	the Wednesday before

HOW TO USE THE CHART:

Step 1) In the **LEFT** column, point at what day your appointment is on.

Step 2) Follow directly across to the box on the right

Step 3) the weekday listed in the box on the **RIGHT** is the day you **must** call us by

EXAMPLE: If your appointment is on TUESDAY you must call us by the THURSDAY prior! 😊



More IMPORTANT Client Information - Please Read!

Forgetting to call and schedule ahead happens to all of us. If you have questions or concerns about scheduling requests, contact us so we can explain further.

Thank you for working with us and keeping things running smoothly 😊

Remember! You can call us as soon as you know you need a ride, even if it's weeks in advance. The earlier the better!



Volunteer Updates! New Way to Sign-Up for Requests!

If you're an Interfaith Caregiver's volunteer, you're probably pretty familiar with the sound of our Client and Volunteer Service Coordinator, Mickey's, voice. Chances are, she has called you! 😊

Mickey spends quite a bit of her time talking with clients and volunteers over the phone.

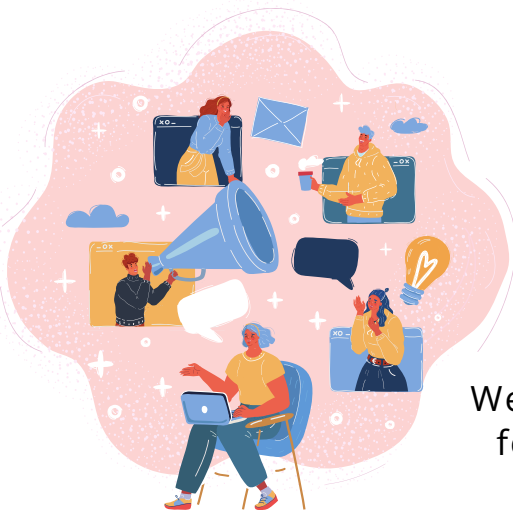
Getting the opportunity to know these folks on a personal level is one of the best parts of what we do here at Interfaith! While we don't want to lose the personal connection with our volunteers, we want to help everyone as efficiently as possible!

We would like to try out a new process to fill client requests (due in part to the high volume of requests, as well as the number of calls to fill each one.)

IMPORTANT!

- ① On **Monday** of each week, we'll be sending out a "snapshot" of the current schedule via your preferred contact method on file.
- ② If you're free to volunteer for a request, you can: self-assign online, give us a call, send us an email, or shoot us a text.
- ③ Once we hear from you, we'll put you on the schedule and send you the request details.
- ④ If a request hasn't been filled and time is running out, staff will start reaching out to volunteers directly.
- ⑤ Reply "STOP" if you do not want to receive the Monday "snapshot".

We're excited to start this new process and welcome your feedback. This small change in the way we fill requests should help everyone in the long run!

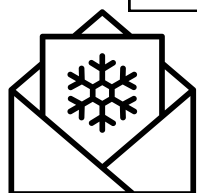
